We know its been a long time coming, but hopefully you've seen the new gates. This labor of love was installed by Quality Control Systems who has added a one year warranty at no cost as part of the gate installation award. QCS has become our new gate and camera system provider replacing TEM. In early April, we will be replacing the camera system and upgrading the hardware to improve our ability to read license plates especially at night. The new system will be integrated with a license plate database and Infra Red backlit detection capabilities.



All of these upgrades to the community are well within our currrent budget and reserve account plans and the gates were also funded by a \$36,000 insurance claim from the tractor trailer that hit the front entrance gate last year.

We will be sending a reminder notice when we have details of the camera installation which is expected to take a day or so. In closing, I'd like to send a BIG Thank you to Mary Kyryk who supported the gate RFP process and selection which took many hours.

Many thanks also to Jim Schorr in helping to oversee the installation and providing his expert engineering guidance to several unforseen challenges.
